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# INTRODUCTION TO UGM

Universitas Gadjah Mada (UGM) is the first public university established after the independence of Indonesia, 19 December 1949. Located in the heart of Yogyakarta where the traditions of Javanese culture are highly valued, UGM provides a harmonious and comfortable learning environment for its students. Since the beginning, UGM has become a role model and pioneer of higher education in Indonesia. UGM shows a remarkable achievement by becoming the No.1 University in Indonesia, ranks as the 70th best university in Asia, and ranks as the 254th best university in the world based on QS World University Rankings 2021.

As a leading Indonesian university, UGM aims to promote excellence in educational activities, research, and community service with the interest of the Indonesian society and to participate in Indonesian socio-cultural development. Therefore, UGM equips the student with the knowledge and skills to succeed in their chosen career in a competitive global market. UGM offers various education programs (18 faculties, 2 schools and more than 200 study programs) equipped with professional teaching staff with an outstanding educational and research background. As an effort to realize the needs of the nation, UGM also provides 26 studies and research centers in various scientific studies. This is intended to accommodate the diverse interest of the UGM community in research activities.

Students admitted to UGM come from 34 provinces and 514 cities in Indonesia, overseas countries, and regions in the world. The cultural diversity created has been integrated in harmony as UGM's identity. In addition, the alumni networks of UGM are also becoming one of the strongest and largest in Indonesia. Its alumni have become the leaders in Indonesian and global society for decades. For instance, the ruling President and a number of Ministers of the Republic of Indonesia are graduate of UGM.

# DEGREE PROGRAMS

AT UNIVERSITAS GADJAH MADA

Universitas Gadjah Mada offers various programs in different fields.

To provide a more comprehensive learning option, UGM has 18 faculties, graduate school and vocational college for students.

The programs in each faculties consist of:

### 3 | **REGULAR UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAM**

The Regular Undergraduate Program is UGM's regular undergraduate degree program. This program is taught in Bahasa Indonesia.

Therefore, prospective students are advised to have basic knowledge of Bahasa Indonesia in advance.

### 1 | **INTERNATIONAL UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAM**

The International Undergraduate Program (IUP) is Universitas Gadjah Mada's flagship program which is organized by undergraduate study programs in a number of faculties.

This program is taught in English and requires students to gain international exposures during their study.

### 4 | **REGULAR POSTGRADUATE PROGRAM**

The Regular Postgraduate Program is UGM's regular postgraduate degree program. This program is taught in Bahasa Indonesia.

Therefore, prospective students are advised to have basic knowledge of Bahasa Indonesia in advance.

### 2 | **INTERNATIONAL POSTGRADUATE PROGRAM**

The International Postgraduate Program is UGM's flagship program which is organized by postgraduate study programs in a number of faculties.

This program is taught in English.

### 5 | **DOUBLE DEGREE PROGRAM**

The Double Degree Program is UGM's undergraduate or postgraduate program that enables prospective students to attend classes at UGM and UGM's partner universities. The students will hold degrees from both universities.

# FACULTY OF ANIMAL SCIENCE

The Faculty of Animal Science is the youngest faculty in UGM which was originally part of the Faculty of Veterinary.

The Faculty of Animal Science was officially established on 22 November 1969 and has around 2000 students and it is supported by 73 lecturers, who are competent in their fields, 75% of them have a doctorate and 90 academic staff.

It offers degree programs ranging from undergraduate, master, doctoral, and engineering professions.

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# FACULTY OF BIOLOGY

The Faculty of Biology was established on September 19, 1955. During its initial years as a new faculty, the Faculty of Biology experienced many dynamic changes. One of those that significantly influenced the development of the Faculty of Biology is the founding of the SPB.

The SPB is a bachelor degree program in the Faculty of Biology, besides two other graduate study programs, those are Master Program and Doctorate Program in Biology.

In 1983 until 1995, the Faculty of Biology had three departments, those were: the Department of Botany, the Department of Zoology, and the Department of Environmental Biology. Afterward, in 1995, the three departments were merged into a single study program, that was called SPB.

The curriculum of SPB was then developed into 3 streams, namely, (i) biodiversity and environmental biology (ii) functional biology, and (iii) molecular biology and biotechnology.

# FACULTY OF MATHEMATICS AND NATURAL SCIENCES

The faculty that educates students in the area of Mathematics and Natural Sciences at the University of Gadjah Mada were inaugurated on 19 September 1955 with the Decree of the Ministry of Education and Culture dated 15 September 1955 No 53 759/Kab.

In a letter, this decision is still a faculty combined with the so-called Union of the Faculty of Engineering and Faculty of Natural Sciences. Since September 1, 1956, the faculty of science (abbreviated FIPA) has begun to separate itself from the Faculty of Engineering. At the time of the Faculty Association, the new FIPA had one Department which was then called the Department of Science.

# FACULTY OF GEOGRAPHY

In 1950, the Faculty of Geography UGM was originally one of the majors at the Faculty of Literature, Pedagogic and Philosophy, namely the Department of Earth Sciences. In 1956, this Faculty was changed to the Faculty of Literature and Culture. The Department of Earth Sciences was growing rapidly during that time.

The role of Earth Sciences expert was increasingly acknowledged in the field of regional development and was getting wider on a national level network, that eventually the Faculty of Letters and Culture proceeded the Department of Earth Science to change to the Faculty of Geography on 1st September 1963 which is commemorated as the birth of this faculty.

On its development, the Faculty was then assigned to have three departments that nurtured seven study programs.

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The Faculty of Philosophy of Gadjah Mada University was established on August 18, 1967, with the Director General of Higher Education Decree Number 90/1967 dated August 7, 1967. The idea of establishing the Faculty of Philosophy was triggered mainly because of the increasingly urgent need in the field of education development in general, and science in particular, especially basic science and general knowledge (studium generale). This is based on the fact that philosophy has a central position in science. Since the 1992/1993 Academic Year, the Faculty of Philosophy opened the Postgraduate Program for Magister Program (S-2) accredited A BAN-PT 2015, and then in the 1997/1998 academic year opened the Doctoral Program (S-3) accredited A BAN-PT 2015.

The Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, Universitas Gadjah Mada (FKH UGM) is one of the oldest Veterinary Medicine Faculty in Indonesia. The Faculty of Veterinary Medicine currently manages 4 study programs namely the Bachelor of Veterinary Medicine Program (S1), Veterinarian Profession (DVM), Veterinary Magister (S2) and Doctoral Science (S3). The Faculty of Veterinary Medicine continuously improves the quality of education through internal academic quality audits, in 2016 all study programs were accredited A by BAN PT.

Undergraduate and Profession study programs have been certified by the ASEAN University Network (AUN) and academic quality has also been improved through improving the quality of academic services with ISO 9001: 2008 certification. This quality assurance is an ongoing effort of the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine to be able to produce high quality graduates above the average quality of national education and able to compete at the international level.

# STUDENTS EXCHANGE PROGRAM

In order to participate in the exchange program, students must first be nominated by their home university. This program could be participated by undergraduate students, master students or doctoral students. *Doctoral students need to be discussed by the research counterpart or potential supervisor at UGM and the internal UGM itself.*

In this student exchange program, international students could choose any department or study program or faculty to study without any exception. Students are also allowed to choose courses from more than one faculty. However, their host study program would be the study program which has a majority chosen courses.

In addition, the language of instruction in Universitas Gadjah Mada is mainly in Bahasa Indonesia. But, prospective students may choose English-taught courses from international undergraduate programs or international postgraduate programs.

In addition to nominated students from UGM's partner universities, other students with the following criteria are also eligible to apply for student exchange program as a 'free mover':

- **Students from partner universities but not officially nominated by home universities.**

In this case, you still have to apply through your home university as a self-funded exchange student.

- **Students from universities which do not have an exchange agreement with UGM yet.**

*We welcome a limited number of exchange students from non-partner universities every semester. However, exchange students from partner universities have priority rights considering specific entry requirements, limited capacity and so on.*

# LANGUAGE COURSE (INCULS)

The Indonesian Language and Culture Learning Service (INCULS) at Faculty of Arts and Humanities, Universitas Gadjah Mada, was established in 2000 as a substitute of what was formerly known as Pusat Studi Indonesia (PSI) from 1987, then Learning Bahasa Indonesia as A Foreign Language (LBIFL) from 1992 and Non-Aligned Government (NAG) in 1993.

It aims to provide courses and workshops for foreigners who are interested in Indonesian, Indonesian Culture, and local languages.



The language teachers and tutors are trained in both the Natural Approach and the Communicative Teaching Method, in which direct pertinence to real life situations and constant interaction are emphasized. The culture teachers are all qualified faculty members of various departments at Universitas Gadjah Mada.

The program consists of regular programs, private programs and intensive programs. The Tuition Fee for this Regular Program is IDR 13.692.300,00/semester (offline class) and IDR 10.269.225,00/semester (online class during COVID-19 Pandemic). This tuition fee only covers the academic fees, including course books and exercise books.

As an addition, INCULS also organized:

- Special lectures (on the Indonesian economy, cultures, politics, history, literature, etc.)
- Village studies,
- Tutorial with Gadjah Mada Univ. student
- Cooking Indonesian Foods
- Workshops (making batik, gamelan, traditional dance, etc.).



All applicants are advised to prepare the required documents as implied in the program description in advance before submitting the application. Once the application is received through the system, the Office of International Affairs and all parties assigned will process the application.

Successful applicants will get the Letter of Acceptance and the Office of International Affairs will process their study permit application to the Ministry of Education and Culture and visa preparation for applicants. # GADJAH MADA INTERNATIONAL FELLOWSHIP (GMIF)

The Gadjah Mada International Fellowship (GMIF) program is a scholarship offered by Universitas Gadjah Mada (UGM) to international students coming from, but not limited to, ASEAN member countries (excluding Indonesia), South Korea, Japan, China, Taiwan, and other countries that manage to demonstrate the need of financial assistance.

This program is designated for full-time Master and Doctoral degrees by coursework and research in Bahasa Indonesia taught. The purpose of the GMIF program is to encourage potential candidates with excellent academic performance who wish to pursue the Master and Doctoral Program in any relevant and agreed field. ## KEMITRAAN NEGARA BERKEMBANG (KNB SCHOLARSHIP)


